SYDNEY CHURCH OF ENGLAND GIRLS GRANNAR SCHOOL ORDINANCE (NO. 2) 1976

Mo. 50 1976

AM OBDINANCE to vary the trusts on which sertain property is held and to confer additional power on Sydney Church of England Girls' Grammar School Council.

NHIBERAS it is expedient that the trusts on which certain property being the trust fund described in the Sydney Church of England Girls' Grammar Schools Assistance Ordinance 1974 - 1975 is held to be varied to the extent hereinafter provided AND NHIBERAS it is expedient that additional powers be conferred upon Sydney Church of England Girls' Grammar School Council NOW the Standing Councittee in the name and place of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney HERREY ORDAINS DECLARS DIRECTS AND BULES as follows:-

- 1. (1) Sydney Church of England Girls' Grammar School Council (hereinafter called "SCRGGS") is hereby authorized and empowered to sell any land and any other assets vested in it for such price and on and subject to such terms and conditions as SCRGGS in its absolute discretion considers fit and to this end to grant an option or options to purchase in recreet of any land and any other assets vested in it.
- (2) SCRGGS is hereby authorised and empowered to execute and deliver any agreement or deed, to which Bill Acceptance Corporation Limited is a party, which includes or gives effect to the provisions set forth in the Schedule hereto.
- (3) SCHOOL subject to the said agreement or deed being executed and delivered by all parties thereto is hereby authorised empowered and directed to pay to Bill Acceptance Corporation Limited the several amounts set forth in the Schedule hereto in the manner indicated therein.

- 2. (1) By reason of dirfusstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts on which the property described as the "trust fund" in the Sydney Church of England Girls' Grammar Schools Assistance Ordinance 1974 1975 is held it has become inexpedient to carry out and observe such trusts to the extent to which the same are hereby varied.
- (2) The said property shall be held upon trust to pexhit the same (or the proceeds from the realisation of the same) being applied as follows:-
 - (a) as to such amount not exceeding PIVR MUNDEED TROUBAND DOLLARS

 (\$500,000) as SCHOGS may determine by resolution thereof by

 way of loan or grant to any purchaser of part of the land

 vested in SCHOGS being land on which SCHOGS conducted its

 Darlinghurst School; which proposes to continue that

 school as a Christian school in monordance with the

 principles of the Church of England in Australia;
- (b) as to the balance by way of loan or grant to SCHGGS; which loans shall be made on and subject to such terms and conditions as SCHGGS, in its discretion considers appropriate.
- 3. This Ordinance may be cited as "Sydney Church of England Girls' Grassar School Ordinance (No. 2) 1976".

SCHEDULE

1. In this Schedule:-

"SCEGGE" means Sydney Church of England Girls' Grammar School Council;

"MAC" means Mill Acceptance Comporation Limited;

"BAC debt" means and includes all moneys which are now or may hereafter become payable by SCHOGS to BAC or which BAC may claim are payable by SCHOGS to BAC;

"Darlinghurst land" means all land situated at Darlinghurst and which is vested in SCEGE;

"Darlinghurst school" means the part of the Darlinghurst land on which SCEGGS conducted its Darlinghurst school; and

"Moss Vale land" means all land situated sear Moss Vale and which is vested in SCEGGS.

- 2. BLC shall grant partial discharges of the mortgages granted by SCEGGS to BLC to the extent necessary to enable SCEGGS to sell the Darlinghurst land and SCEGGS shall pay the net sale proceeds realized on the sale of the same to BLC in reduction of the BLC debt.
- 3. Subject to SCE305 entering a contract to sell the Darlinghurst School for an amount that is not less than CME MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000.00) SCE335 shall pay to BAC on or prior to the list of December 1976 in reduction of the BAC debt a sum equal to TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000.00) less the amount of the said purchase price.
- 4. Upon SCEGGS recovering any moneys from The Law Society of New South Wales SCEGGS shall pay the sum after meeting any costs of recovering the same to BAC in reduction of the BAC debt.
- 5. SCEGGS shall pay to BAC on or price to the 31st of December 1977 in reduction of the BAC debt the greater of:-
 - (a) the sum of Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) and
 - (b) the proceeds from the sale of the Moss Vale land (after meeting all costs in connection with that sale and that property and discharging all mortgages to which that property is subject as at the 15th of Movember 1976) if that property is sold before the 31st of December 1977.
- 6. If the aggregate of the amounts paid, prior to the 31st
 December 1977 by SCHOOS to BAC is less than THREE MYLLICH
 FOUR HUMBED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,400,000.00) SCHOOS shall
 pay to BAC an amount equal to the deficiency on the 31st
 December 1977 in reduction of the BAC debt.
- 7. BAC shall covenant with SCEGGS that so long as SCEGGS complies with the provisions of Clauses 2 to 6, NAC shall not reak to recover any part of the BAC debt or seek to wind up SCEGGS or have SCEGGS wound up.
- 8. BAC acknowledges that its entitlement to the BAC debt is limited to such amount as may be payable by SCEGGS to BAC pursuant to Clauses 2 to 6 and acknowledges that in relation to the BAC debt it has no claim and releases any claim that it might otherwise have against any member of SCEGGS (past present or future) or any other member or agency of the Church of England in Australia.
- 9. BAC acknowledges that upon 3CB005 paying to BAC the amount payable by SCB008 to BAC pursuant to Clauses 3 to 6 SCB003 shall thereupon be released from all obligation and liabilities whatsoever that SCE008 may have to BAC.
