Sydney Church of England Grammar School (Amendment) 1922.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the "Sydney Church of England Grammar School Ordinance of 1894" and the Ordinance amending the same.

Whereas it is expedient to further amend the "Sydney Church of England Grammar School Ordinance of 1894" The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 and otherwise ordains and rules as follows:—

- 1. Section 2 of the "Sydney Church of England Grammar School (Amendment) Ordinance 1910" is hereby amended by omitting the words "remaining members of the Council" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "appointment of a person by the Standing Committee."
- 2. The Synod may by resolution determine that any vacancy now or hereafter existing when the Synod is in Session shall not be filled during such Session and thereupon after the close of such Session such vacancy may be filled by the Standing Committee in lieu of the Synod under the provisions of the said Ordinances as amended by this Ordinance.
- 3. At the first ordinary Session of the next ensuing Synod of the Diocese seven elected members of the Council, namely, three Clergymen and four Laymen, shall retire but shall be eligible for re-election and the members to retire shall, failing agreement among the members, be determined by the Standing Committee by ballot.

At the first ordinary Session of the succeeding Synod of the Diocese the remaining elected members of the Council, namely, four Clergymen, and three Laymen, shall retire but shall be eligible for re-election. Thereafter at the first ordinary Session of each Synod of the Diocese seven elected members of the Council shall retire, but shall be elegible for re-election, and the members shall retire in rotation according to their length of time of office.

Sydney Church of England Grammar School (Amendment) 1922,

Members elected to fill extraordinary vacancies shall retire at the times at which the members whose places they were elected to fill were due for retirement.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Sydney Church of England Grammar School (Amendment) Ordinance 1922,"
