

SYDNEY CHURCH ORDINANCE AMENDMENT ORDINANCE 1988

No 35, 1989

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Sydney Church Ordinance with respect to the use of church trust property.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sydney Church Ordinance 1912 (hereinafter called "the Principal Ordinance") with respect to the use of church trust property.

NOW the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney HEREBY ORDAINS DECLARES DIRECTS AND RULES as follows.

Citation

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Sydney Church Ordinance Amendment Ordinance 1988".

Amendment

2. The Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting the following clause:

"20A (1) No pre-school, kindergarten, school or college, or similar educational activity requiring governmental registration, licence or authorisation shall hereafter be commenced or after 1 January 1991 be conducted by any Minister, Churchwarden, Parish Council or Church Committee on behalf of any Parish or Church on any church trust property or other property except -

(a) by a committee or body corporate established or constituted by ordinance of the Standing Committee or of the Synod;

(b) with the consent of the Standing Committee or of the Synod given by resolution thereof after it has determined that the application has satisfied Diocesan Guidelines if any; or

(c) by a lessee or licensee under a lease or licence granted by the Property Trust.

(2) In subsection (1), "committee" does not include churchwardens exercising any power or powers granted to them pursuant to the Sydney Church Ordinance 1912, a Parish Council or a Church Committee."
