

Synod Fund Application Ordinance 2013

No 46, 2013

Long Title

An Ordinance to provide for the application of certain property for the purposes of settling claims.

Preamble

A. The Sydney Diocesan Secretariat holds certain property on behalf of the Synod on certain trusts for the purposes of the Diocese in a fund known as Synod Fund 131 (the "Fund").

B. By reason of circumstances which have arisen after the creation of the trusts on which the Fund is held it is inexpedient to carry out or observe those trusts and it is expedient to vary those trusts to provide for application of the Fund for the purposes of settling claims.

The Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ordains as follows.

1. Name

This Ordinance is the Synod Fund Application Ordinance 2013.

2. Declaration

By reason of circumstances which have arisen after the creation of the trusts on which the Fund is held it is inexpedient to carry out or observe those trusts and it is expedient to vary those trusts to the extent necessary to make the payments referred to in clause 3.

3. Direction for payment

(1) The Sydney Diocesan Secretariat is to apply an amount or amounts from the Fund for the purposes of settling claims in accordance with subclause (2).

(2) The Standing Committee is to determine by resolution –

- (a) the amount or amounts to be applied from the Fund, and
- (b) the claims that may be settled using such amount or amounts.
