Trusteeship S. Mark's Glebe.

An ORDINANCE requesting the Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney to accept the Trusteeship of the Glebe known as St. Mark's Glebe Sydney and directing them not to enquire into or take any action in respect of the past administration of the trusts relating thereto.

Whereas it is expedient that certain Glebe lands situated at Randwick near Sydney and known as St. Mark's Glebe should be vested in the Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney (hereinafter referred to as "The Corporate Trustees") and in the event of their accepting the Trusteeship thereof that they should be relieved from the obligation (if any) of enquiring into or taking action in respect of the past administration of the trusts relating to the said Glebe The Synon of the Process of Synone or the past and rules as follows:—

- 1. That the Corporate Trustees are hereby requested to accept the office of Trustees of the said Glebe and in the event of their accepting the Trusteeship thereof they are hereby relieved from the obligation (if any) of enquiring into or taking any action in respect of the past administration of the trusts relating thereto.
- This Ordinance may be cited as "The St. Mark's Glebe Trustees Acceptance Ordinance 1910."
