

Use of Church Property Ordinance 1995 Amendment Ordinance 2000

No 30, 2000

Long Title

An Ordinance to amend the Use of Church Property Ordinance 1995.

Preamble

A. The Use of Church Property Ordinance 1995 (the "Principal Ordinance") makes general provision for a church of another denomination to use church trust property for a purpose of that church pursuant to section 32B of the Trust Property Act.

B. Section 32B of the Trust Property Act confers on the Synod like powers in relation to land or other property that is for the time being subject to a trust for the use, benefit or purpose of a church of another denomination as it has under the Trust Property Act in relation to church trust property.

C. The powers of the Synod under section 32B have been delegated to the Standing Committee under section 40 of the Trust Property Act.

D. By reason of circumstances that have arisen subsequent to the creation of the trusts under the Principal Ordinance, it is inexpedient to carry out or observe such trusts.

The Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ordains as follows.

1. Name

This Ordinance is the Use of Church Property Ordinance 1995 Amendment Ordinance 2000.

2. Declaration

By reason of circumstances that have arisen subsequent to the creation of the trusts under the Principal Ordinance, it is inexpedient to carry out or observe such trusts.

3. Amendment

In clause 7 of the Principal Ordinance the matter "2000" is deleted and "2005" is inserted instead.
