W. Percy Faithfull Church of England Charities Distribution Ordinance 1970

No. 66, 1970

An Ordinance to provide for the distribution of the bequest of the late William Percy Faithfull amongst certain Church of England Charities.

WHEREAS by the last Will and Testament of William Percy Faithfull of Neutral Bay near Sydney in the State of New South Wales dated the First day of May 1924 it was provided that, subject to the provisions therein contained, the Trustces thereof shall pay one equal half-share of what in the Will was designated "the remainder of the trust premises" to the Synod of the Church of England Diocese of Sydney to be distributed by the Synod amongst the Church of England charities in New South Wales in such proportions and in such manner as such Synod may direct AND WHEREAS the said half-share together with any resultant income therefrom (which half-share and income are hereinafter called "the said bequest") was received by Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney (hereinafter called the "Corporate Trustee" from the Trustees of the said Will pursuant to and by virtue of the authority of the W. Percy Faithfull Church of England Charities Ordinance 1940 AND WHEREAS the Corporate Trustee was directed by the W. Percy Faithfull Church of England Charities Ordinance 1970 to distribute the said bequest and all income which has accrued thereon (after payment thereout of certain costs) to such of the Church of England Charities in New South Wales and in such proportions and upon and subject to such terms and conditions as the Standing Committe may by ordinance designate AND WHEREAS the amount to be distributed is approximately One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) NOW the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney HEREBY ORDAINS DECLARES DIRECTS AND RULES as follows:-

- 1. The Corporate Trustee shall distribute to each charity designated in the first coloumn of the Schedule hereto the amount designated in the second column of the Schedule hereto opposite the name of that charity.
- 2. The Corporate Trustee shall distribute to each charity designated in the first column of the Schedule hereto that sum which bears to the balance of the amount to be distributed (after the distributions provided for in Clause 1 have been made) the same ratio as the amount designated in the second column of the Schedule hereto opposite the name of that charity bears to One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

- *3. Any distribution made by the Corporate Trustee pursuant to Clauses I or 2 hereof to any charity designated in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall be made by the Corporate Trustee on and subject to the terms and conditions (if any) designated in the third column of the Schedule hereto opposite the name of that charity.
- 4. This Ordinance may be cited as the "W. Percy-Faithfull Church of England Charities Distribution Ordinance 1970".
